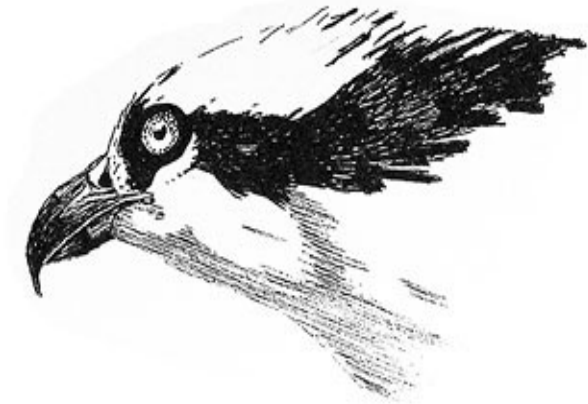


Checklist of the Birds of Kiawah Island, South Carolina
